Dear Residents,

To protect yourself and others from exposure to the COVID-19 virus, we all must adhere to the following rules:

- No visitors are allowed in the building. Times will be allocated for staff to help you visit with your friends and family using technology such as FaceTime, Skype and Zoom.
- You should not leave the building except for necessities such as medical appointments and groceries. If you do leave, you must use the main entrance and sign-out at reception.
- When coming back into the building, you must wash your hands, sign-in, complete a health questionnaire, and have your temperature taken.
- Staff and contractors are also required to sign-in, complete a health questionnaire, have their temperature taken and wash their hands on entering the building.
- Wash your hands when you leave your room and when you return to your room.
- Tables in the dining room have been rearranged to allow for the maximum possible physical distance between residents.
- Meals will no longer be served to apartment residents who do not have a meal plan. Take out meals will be provided instead.
- Activities are limited to five residents and require appropriate physical distancing. Hilary is busy thinking of new ways to keep you engaged and entertained.
