The Chief Medical Officer of Health issued a new order on May 19<sup>th</sup>. As a result, there will be some changes to some of our processes, effective immediately, as follows:

- Residents will be screened upon re-entry only if they leave the facility property on a resident outing. You will not have to complete a form like before. Instead, the Commissionaire will ask you the questions and take your temperature. However, we will have a binder at the Commissionaire's table where you print your name, the date and time of entry and time of exit and your phone number.
- Residents are not required to have screening completed when they leave the building to go outdoors on the Cypress View Foundation property (e.g. outdoors for fresh air or to smoke, etc.).
- Low risk activities will be planned, including worship services, crafts, exercise, games, indoor and outdoor performances including singers, music, etc. The size of these activities will still be limited based on the activity and the space it is held in.
- Higher risk activities (such as indoor group singing, preparing food, etc.) will not be planned.

All residents must still enter the building through the front door **only**. There have been instances when residents are letting other residents in exterior doors, especially the door just outside the smoking shelter. It is important that all residents still come back in through the front door, even if you have only been on the grounds.
